## Member Code of Conduct

The following document should be presented to: Officials, parents and players of the Rage Soccer Club organization who should sign a copy and return it to the club to hold on file.

### Rage Soccer Club agrees to provide:

- A safe environment in which the player can learn and develop without fear.
- A structured soccer-learning program, appropriate to the age, ability and growth of the individual player.
- Participation in matches and tournaments approved by recognized leagues and tournament organizers.
- A Staff who is developing on an ongoing basis, who is encouraged and supported to gain recognized qualifications by National coaching education agencies.
- Guidance to parents and players on the best way to support and contribute to the player's soccer and personal development.
- Regular communication on the clubs status and new initiatives.
- Feedback on an individual player's progress, growth, and indicate future participation in the program.

### Players agree to:

- Attend practice sessions and games on time and notify the club in advance of any absence.
- Attend all practice sessions and games with a positive attitude towards learning.
- Follow a lifestyle appropriate to development and supporting this with spending leisure time positively.
- Represent the club in a positive manner both during and outside of club commitments.
- Respect coaches, fellow players, and officials on the field of play along with the opposition and their officials at ALL times.
- Adhere to ALL soccer rules and codes enforced by the governing bodies of soccer to which BSA/Rage is affiliated.
- Be a positive role model to all soccer players with whom they come in contact with locally, regionally, nationally and internationally.

### Parents agree to:

- Encourage and support the player to meet the needs of this code of conduct.
- Support the player without pressure, praise good work and refrain from criticizing any lapses of performance.
- Set a good example to all players in terms of behavior and conduct at practice sessions and matches.
- Respect coaches, players, and officials on the field of play along with the opposition and their officials at ALL times.
- Respect the opportunity given to the player to participate in the Rage Soccer Club.
- Communicate with Rage staff and inform them of any matters affecting the player from outside of the Rage organization.
- Select an appropriate time with notice given, to approach coaching staff concerning players participation and performance
- Adhere to this code of conduct set out by the Rage Soccer Club.

**Failure of the Player or Parent to abide by any terms of this Code of Conduct as set forth above, or as may be amended from time to time by Rage Soccer Club, shall result in such disciplinary action as may be determined to be appropriate in the sole discretion of the Academy Director. Disciplinary action may include, but not by limited to, the issuance of a warning letter, suspension from practice, suspension from games, and expulsion from the Rage Soccer Club. No proration of dues paid to the Rage Soccer Club shall be made in the event of suspension. No refund of dues paid to the Rage Soccer Club shall be made in the event a Parent and/or Player is expelled.**
